2. APPROVAL AND SIGNING OF THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING HELD ON 10th MAY 2004. Mr Cutler proposed and Mr Short seconded that the minutes be signed as a true and accurate record of events. AIF

4. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION (from the floor)

- a) Mr Bosworth reported problems on the underpass with lights being vandalized. Highway will be informed AW
- b) Mr Bosworth reported problems with children playing around the Ancient Monument/Dark Hole. Mr Rowell has walked around the site and can find no real damage only a small amount of sheep netting that is down. It is suggested that parishioners contact the Parish Council again if the problem persists.
- c) Mr Davey reported a request to mark out a small pitch with smaller goals on the Leisure Field. There are also problems with dogs fouling on the field. Mr Davey registered his support for the Parish Council over the issues of buses coming through the village and support of the Speedwatch initiative. AW
- d) The dog bin outside the School needs to be replaced AW
- e) The litter bin on School Lane has disappeared and needs to be replaced. AW
- f) Mr Peck expressed his concerns that the issues with the lack of parental support for the Youth Club, speeding and vandalism are symptomatic of a community that is not working together. Mr Davey pointed out that despite this there is a lot of positive in the community, the membership of 40 for the Youth Club being just one.
- g) Mr Davey thanked the Parish Council for all of their hard work.
- h) Mr Reid pointed out that Warmington had been missed off a map of areas to visit in a recent edition of the Nene Valley News.
- i) Mr Constant pointed out that Mr Du Croz had suggested that the VDS needs to be updated. It was agreed to ask Mr Du Croz for a synopsis of the areas that need updating and discuss it at the next meeting. AW
- j) Mr Rowell asked if "The Chair" could be cut back into the hedge along the old A605. Mr Short suggested that this was possible.
