Minutes of the full council

24th January 2019 7.30pm

In the Village Hall, Warmington.

Nigel Rudd chaired the meeting as Joanna Simpson had sent advance apologies for her late arrival.

1260. DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS – Cllr. Nigel Rudd reaffirmed his standing personal interest as he is related to someone who works for the planning inspectorate.

1261. QUESTIONS AND STATEMENTS FROM MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC: A question was raised regarding a planning application that was not included on the evening's agenda, but the application in question would be discussed at a future meeting. A number of people reiterated points received by the council during the course of the day regarding the unacceptable condition of the highway now that Northamptonshire County Council has ceased to grit the route through the village. They were thanked for taking the time to attend the meeting.

1262. LICENCE, DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING MATTERS:

It was **RESOLVED** that there were no objections to the proposals.

1263. All papers relating to consideration of the proposed Neighbourhood Plan for final consultation under Regulation 14 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 had been circulated in advance of the meeting so that members could familiarise themselves with it. Steve Cheeseman presented the pertinent parts of the plan and explained the next part of the consultation process.

It was **RESOLVED** to adopt this version of the plan so that it can be publicised in accordance with that regulation, in a manner that is likely to bring it to the attention of people who live, work or carry on business in the neighbourhood area as well as statutory consultation bodies and the local planning authority. The consultation would be published the following day with a deadline of March 8th. Hard copies would be placed in the library, church and village shop, with instructions as to how to respond included. The intention would be to sign off the next stage of the process at the meeting of 8th April, with interim updates at the governance meeting of 11th March and the WNPPG meeting in the meantime
